

Recommended Qualification Structure (RQS) for Brickwork Technician (Construction) Level 2

This structure has been recommended by employers and stakeholders from the above occupational area for organisations to form the basis of academic capability and competence outcomes. Qualifications with a competence outcome at the above level must have units derived from the following National Occupational Standards (NOS) and consist of the mandatory elements as stated.

MANDATORY

COSVR41v3 Set out to form masonry structures

COSVR250v4 Use access equipment up to six metres

COSVR641v2 Conform to general workplace health, safety and welfare

COSVR642v1 Conform to productive work practices

COSVR643v1 Move, handle or store resources

COSVR810v1 Install and form specialist masonry elements

Unit endorsements for Brickwork Technician Level 2

Where industry requests; qualifications can be endorsed to show an option route and the type of resources and/or activities that relate to the unit. Listed below are the endorsements that can apply for units derived from the following NOS.

VR41	Four of the following: Straight (180 degrees) Right angles (90 degrees) Obtuse angles (between 90 and 180 degrees including batters) Acute angles (between 0 and 90 degrees) Curves on plan Curves in elevation Openings
VR250	Two or more of the following: Ladders Stepladders/platform steps Proprietary towers Podiums Mobile scaffold towers
VR810	Install fire barriers and/or fire breaks and support angles And/or Form fire barriers and/or fire breaks and support angles Plus at least two of the following: Brick soffit systems Channel systems Wind posts Vapour and/or moisture barriers Wall starter kits

Note: Where industry requests an Awarding Organisation to further endorse a unit, the Awarding Organisation must first seek approval from the Standards Setting Body to ensure the endorsement is appropriate to the unit.
