

Recommended Qualification Structure for Wood Preserving – Industrial Pre-treatment (Construction) Level 2

This structure has been recommended by employers and stakeholders from the above occupational area for organisations to form the basis of academic capability and competence outcomes. Qualifications with a competence outcome at the above level must have units derived from the following National Occupational Standards (NOS) and consist of the mandatory group as stated.

MANDATORY (Total 6)

- VR17 Prepare timber for treatment, dry and store treated timber
- VR18 Prepare timber treatment chemicals
- VR19 Operate and maintain timber treatment plant
- VR641 Conform to general workplace health, safety and welfare
- VR642 Conform to productive work practices
- VR643 Move, handle or store resources
