

# Third Quarter Report 01/02/2020 – 30/04/2020

Third quarter was not as successful as previous quarters. Due to uncertainty of labour markets related to the COVID-19 pandemic that started mid quarter, we did not engage any residents or employers related to the programme. No events or courses were held

No additional closure costs occurred, following the decision to cease the programme.

## Overall Summary:

From the beginning of the contract, Croydon Works engaged over 70 residents specifically for the CITB programme, including 36 women for the course focusing on training women towards work in construction.

Apart from general employability training, Croydon Works enabled 11 women and 24 Long Term Unemployed who did not have any previous construction experience to obtain CSCS qualification, and organised Work Placements with all the construction companies engaged specifically during this contract.

Following the successful completion of training, two women who still declared interest in working in construction sector, secured permanent and sustainable employment within the local construction sites. Several other residents completed work placements and either moved on to other sectors, or are still looking for employment within the construction sector that has slowed down drastically since March. We are continuing to work with those who registered with our service, looking at all suitable employment options.
