Freedom of Information Request: 372020

Thank you for contacting CITB requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Your email, dated 13<sup>th</sup> January 2021, asked for the following information:

- 1. How many people work for CITB? (a number for each year over the past five years, including Fixed Term contracts, an average figure for the year is fine as I understand there will be fluctuations)
- 2. How many employees have received paid for training at CITB (so not statutory online training but training that is above and beyond this) in the last 5 year (with a number for each year)?
- 3. The total amount of money this paid internal training for CITB employees accounts for over the last five years (again with a number for each year)?

Our response is as follows:

CITB does not hold the information on training in the categories as requested. The training information is consolidated and includes statutory training. The total cost of all training in the table below includes the cost of statutory training which is required to be taken by all CITB staff.

The following table provides the data requested for Question 1, 2 and 3 for the last 5 years subject to the above proviso:
